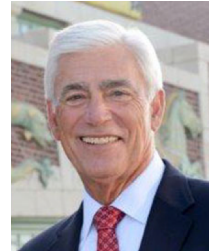

In 2016, Hackensack and Meridian Health System merged and became New Jersey's largest and most profitable "non-profit" healthcare corporation. Combined annual revenues are projected to reach \$5.5 billion this year, and profits have hit \$338 million.

According to 2016 financial documents, Co-CEO Bob Garrett earned \$4.5 million and Co-CEO John Lloyd earned \$3.9 million.

Today, 2,500 nurses and healthcare professionals are working for Hackensack Meridian without a contract. They are fighting for safer patient limits for staff in hospitals and nursing homes. They demand livable wages for workers paid less than \$15 an hour. They deserve lower medical costs and improved access to providers. And they should have a work environment free of intimidation when workers organize a union.
